One family, with one well-cared for herd, producing milk which is gently bottled by hand before it even leaves the farm gate. So, now you really can know exactly where your milk comes from.

You can view the milking, milking parlour and processing room. If it's not time for milking, look at the notice board in the farm shop to see where the cows might be grazing that day. Milking times will also be there, so you can plan a trip based on our activities on the farm. With their own vending machine it's a great place to visit and see the whole process and try some milk too! Meet the cows and calves and learn about dairy farming.

There is plenty of space for your class to roam the fields and look at Habitats and wild life to. It's a great day out but we can also do half days if that suits you better.
